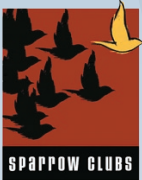




so you think the locals can dance?



Come out and enjoy the 2nd Annual Dancing with the Rogue Valley Stars, November 13, 2010. Dancing with the Rogue Valley Stars is a local dance benefit that's patterned after the popular TV show.



It's not only a fun, family-friendly event, but is also a significant fundraiser for Southern Oregon Sparrow Clubs and the Southern Oregon Chapter of USA Dance. Last year's competition raised over \$15,000.
